INVITATION TO BID DRYLAND INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PROJECT-KARAMOJA PROCUREMENT NOTICE TYPE: WORKS & SUPPLIES

The Government of Uganda has received a credit financing from the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) towards the cost of implementation of the Dryland Integrated Development Project in Karamoja. Office of the Prime Minister is the Executing Agency responsible for the Implementation of the Project through Millennium Promise Alliance Uganda.

The Dryland Integrated Development Project applies a multi sectoral approach aimed at holistically addressing challenges faced by pastoralist communities that directly contribute to the objective of reducing vulnerability, building resilience and improving people's livelihoods in the districts of Moroto, Napak, Nakapiripirit and Amudat.

The Office of the Prime Minister, through the Project Implementation Unit based in Moroto intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing for the procurement of works and supplies for the communities in the Karamoja region: Moroto, Nakapiripirit, Amudat and Napak Districts. This will be done under the following categories and lots.

WORKS:

A. BUILDING CONSTRUCTION-GRAIN STORES

LOTS:

- Construction of the Lorengedwat & Lotome Grain Stores at Lorengedwat and Lotome Sub Counties located in Nakapiripirit and Napak districts respectively.
- Construction of the Loroo Grain Store at Loroo Sub County, Amudat District.
- Construction of the Nadunget Grain Store at Nadunget Sub County, Moroto District.

B. RENEWABLE ENERGY-COMMUNITY SHARED SOLAR

- Supply and Installation of solar mini grid systems in four sub counties that is: Lorengedwat, Loroo, Nadunget and Lotome in Nakapiripirit, Amudat, Moroto and Napak districts respectively.

C. ROADS

- The construction of the Nangoemor – Achorichor - Loroo (27.5Km) in Nakapiripirit/Amudat Districts.
- Mechanised maintenance of Loroo - Laporokocha Road (7Km) in Loroo sub county Amudat district
- Mechanised maintenance of Nachuka - Kakodareng Road (8.3Km) Nadunget sub county Moroto district
- Mechanized maintenance of Nangamit - Nachuka Lotome & Naronit - Namalera Road Roads (17.9Km) in Lorengedwat and Lotome sub counties in Nakapiripirit and Napak districts

D. WATER

- Sitting and Drilling of 12 to be motorized boreholes in selected villages in Nadunget, Lotome, Lorengedwat and Loroo sub counties in Moroto, Napak, Nakapiripirit and Amudat districts

- Supply and Installation of Four Green Houses at the Learning Centres located at the four sub counties in Lorengedwat, Loroo, Lotome and Nadunget.

- The project implementation unit therefore invites clearly marked and sealed bids from eligible bidders for the provision of the above works and supplies.
- Bidding will be conducted by Open/National Competitive Bidding as per the Islamic Development Bank guidelines and is open to all eligible bidders.
- The Bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon a cash payment of a non-refundable fee of One Hundred Thousand Shillings Only (100,000=UGX) for each lot.
- Site visits are encouraged for all WORKS and a MUST for Categories C&D. These will be guided visits which will be done on three separate dates that is: 7th, 14th and 20th June 2017. Departure Point: Project office at 9:30am on each of these dates. Bidders must endeavor to carry out these visits (at their own cost) and obtain a site visit certificate for works under category C& D that will be signed off by the Project Infrastructure Specialist. This has to be attached as proof of the site visit for bids to be considered for evaluation.
- Bidders are only allowed to bid for a maximum of **TWO (2) LOTS** in the entire advert. The address for payment and picking bid documents is:

Bid securities must be valid until **(28 days) after bid validity period**. Late bids shall be rejected. All bids shall remain valid for 120 days with effect from the bid submission date.
