In line with this, Oxfam in Uganda brings together the joint skillsets of its staff and partners (humanitarian, long-term development, and advocacy) to achieve change at the national level. Oxfam in Uganda also supports and engages in Oxfam's global campaigns, guaranteeing that Uganda is present on the world's most pressing issues. We have recently launched our inequality report and campaign, which considers the dimensions of poverty and drivers of inequality in Uganda. This is aimed at ending inequality in Uganda. We are committed to providing thought leadership on important development issues in the country.

To help contribute to these commitments, we are looking for qualified professionals for the following roles: -

● **GENDER & PROTECTION OFFICER (Based in Lamwo)**

The Gender and Protection Officer will be responsible for the following: promoting identification and integration of the gender and protection elements in the humanitarian program; enhancing protection and gender mainstreaming technical capacity of Oxfam and Partner staff as well as government and community structures; supporting and managing implementation of the Oxfam humanitarian response programme in Uganda. The role supports resource mobilization, specifically for the Emergency Response programme focus areas and ensuring that the promotion of gender and women's rights is at the heart of Oxfam in Uganda's program work in the field.

● **PROJECT MANAGER (Based in Kampala)**

The Project Manager will be responsible for the overall leadership and management of the Building Resilience Education Opportunities in Fragile Crisis Affected Environments project. The jobholder shall; support Oxfam's impact locally, regionally, continentally and globally through ensuring the project's alignment to the key strategic objectives and overall Oxfam program standards; the role supports resource mobilization, specifically for the programme focus areas and ensuring that the promotion of gender and women's rights is at the heart of Oxfam in Uganda's program work.

● **PROJECT OFFICER (Based in Kampala)**

The job holder will be responsible for the coordination of the education in fragile crisis affected environments project nationally by ensuring project alignment to the key strategic objectives and program standards; will support resource mobilization, specifically for areas of the program themes relevant to the focus areas of the project.

● **PROJECT FINANCE OFFICER (Based in Kampala)**

The job holder will be in charge of the financial aspects in relation to the Building Resilience Education Opportunities in Fragile Crisis Affected Environments project. He/she will be responsible for all financial management aspects of the project.

● **PROJECT ACCOUNTANT (Based in Arua)**

The Project Accountant will be responsible for providing the financial aspects of the project portfolios, implementing and monitoring of the financial aspects of assigned projects, managing financial risks and opportunities, and providing appraisal and analysis of the necessary financial aspects of proposals and reports for back-donors. The Project Accountant will be responsible for managing the overall finance operations with a focus on budget tracking, expenditure monitoring, reporting and cash flow management.

● **DRIVER (Based in Arua)**

The driver will be responsible for providing secure and timely driving services to support passengers and/or official goods and any other tasks as required by the field logistics coordinator. The job holder must have a clean driving record and drivers licence.
